### Monday, April 6

#### **Math:**

1. Watch Brainpop Jr. "Grams and Kilograms"

2. Watch "On the Spot" Video: Chapter 10, Lesson 10.9: "Solve Problems About Liquid Volume and Mass".

To find this video:

- a. Go to student dashboard of Go Math on Think Central.
- b. Click on "My Library"
- c. Find and click on the "Math on the Spot Video Tutorial, GK-6".
- d. **Click on Grade 3.** This is important.
- e. Click on Chapter 10.
- f. Click on Lesson 10.9: "Solve Problems About Liquid Volume and Mass".
- g. Watch it!

2. In HARD COPY of MATH BOOK, review pp. 611-614. Complete pp. 615-616. You do not need to send me a picture of these pages.

(\*\*Each lesson in the hard copy book contains about six pages. I ask students to **do at least the two pages at the end of each lesson IN THE HARD COPY MATH BOOK called "Practice and Homework"**. There are usually four problems on the last page that are a review from previous chapters and/or lessons. The review problems help students keep previously taught concepts fresh in their minds, so I like them to do those pages. You do not need to send me any pics of those pages. They are for practice and understanding only.)

3. Math Magician: Try to pass a multiplication!

#### **Reading & Language Arts:**

1. Go through "Words To Know" found on the student dashboard in Wonders. (It is a red circle icon with a blue block in it.)
2. Complete the spelling worksheet (In the "TO DO" section of students' Wonders online). **SAVE IT** by clicking on the small icon on the right that looks like a computer disk with a pencil on the top of it. **THEN, go back to the icon with the notebook paper and click "SUBMIT". Thanks!**
3. Complete the Vocabulary paper (In the "TO DO" section of students' Wonders online). **SAVE IT** by clicking on the small icon on the right that looks like a computer disk with a pencil on the top of it. **THEN, go back to the icon with the notebook paper and click "SUBMIT". Thanks!**
4. Lexia- Complete at least 3 units
5. Read at least 20 minutes.

\*To do assignments in the "TO DO" section, click on the "To Do" icon (it is a green circle with a paper and green check on it) on the student dashboard. Find the small rectangle on the right side of the screen that says "Your Turn Practice Book" or "Grammar", or "Spelling". Then click on the small, black circular cog. It will show a 4-line mini drop down menu. Select "Open interactive Version". Down in the bottom right hand of the screen is a page guide. You can click on the arrows to take you to the pages assigned. You may enlarge or minimize the image with the magnifying glass icons on the bottom right. **TO TYPE ANSWERS**, students need to click on the "T" icon on the bottom left of the screen. Lastly, **SAVE IT** by clicking on the small icon on the right that looks like a computer disk with a pencil on the top of it. **THEN, go back to the icon with the notebook paper and click "SUBMIT". Thanks!**

## Tuesday, April 7

### Math:

1. Do the **Interactive Lesson: Chapter 10, Lesson 9** in "Things To Do" . To find it, follow the instructions below:

I WILL be putting scores in Gradebook for several of the ONLINE INTERACTIVE LESSONS I have assigned. This is how to access them:

1. Find the Think Central (Go Math!) icon in the Granite Portal dashboard (Click on "Core Applications" at the bottom of the dashboard, and click on the Go Math icon that says "Think Central Crestview".)
2. Sign into Think Central (Go Math!). The username and password are both the student's 9#. (The 9# is on the yellow paper I gave out when I issued you a Chromebook on March 18 or 19).
3. Click on "Things To Do".
4. Click on the blue "Chapter 10, Lesson \_ " link.

5. Student will move through the lesson. When he/she gets to the "Personal Math Trainer", CLICK ON THE **ORANGE WHISTLE** and solve the problems. Students are encouraged to use the tabs ("View Example", "Step by Step", "Math on the Spot", etc.) on the right side of the screen to help them.
6. When the student finishes the questions in that section, they must **click the "TURN IT IN" tab at the right** (\*\*please don't click save and exit) for it to show in my teacher report.
7. Next, move to the last part of the interactive lesson and do the Personal Math Trainer with the **RED** whistle.  
CLICK ON THE **RED WHISTLE** and solve the problems. Students are encouraged to use the tabs ("View Example", "Step by Step", "Math on the Spot", etc.) on the right side of the screen to help them.
8. When the student finishes the questions in that section, they must **click the "TURN IT IN" tab** (\*\*please don't click save and exit) at the right for it to show in my teacher report. Then he/she is done with that online interactive lesson.

**SAVE IT** by clicking on the small icon on the right that looks like a computer disk with a pencil on the top of it. **THEN, go back to the icon with the notebook paper and click "SUBMIT". Thanks!**
3. Play at least one of the **vocabulary games** found by clicking on the "GAMES" icon from the student dashboard of Wonders. The icon is an orange circle with a game controller on it.
3. Complete at least three units on LEXIA.
3. Make sure you have read at least 20 minutes.

Wednesday, April 8

**Math:**

3. Math Magician: Try to pass a level!

**Reading:**

1. Read *It's All In the Wind*. It is found by going to the student dashboard of Wonders and clicking on the little circle with a red book on it. If for some reason this does not work, type "*It's All In the Wind*" in the search bar of the student dashboard on Wonders. **If possible, read this story with a parent. Then discuss the story after.**
2. Complete Grammar page (Pronoun-Verb Contractions) in "To Do" list on Wonders online. **SAVE IT by clicking on the small icon on the right that looks like a computer disk with a pencil on the top of it. THEN, go back to the icon with the notebook paper and click "SUBMIT". Thanks!**
3. Play the spelling game found by clicking on the "GAMES" icon from the student dashboard of Wonders. The icon is an orange circle with a game controller on it.
4. Do Lexia until you have completed three units.
5. Make sure you have read at least 20 minutes. (That can include time spent reading *It's All In the Wind*.)
